### Damping Off

Howard F. Schwartz

(*Pythium*, *Rhizoctonia*, *Fusarium* spp.): pre or post emergence wilting and death of seedlings. Roots and hypocotyls are discolored, water-soaked and/or rotted. Other controls include crop rotation, deep tillage and recommended planting date.
