## Nematode Diseases

### Introduction

Many nematode species are found in association with bean roots. Two species that cause significant yield reductions are the root-knot (*Meloidogyne* spp.) and lesion (*Pratylenchus* spp.) nematodes. These species and the chrysanthemum foliar nematode, *Aphelenchoides ritzemabosi*, reported on bean in Wyoming are discussed in various regional production and IPM bulletins.
